The 2019 Annual Meeting of Stockholders of Monolithic Power Systems, Inc. (the "Company") will be held at 4040 Lake Washington Blvd. NE, Suite 201, Kirkland, WA 98033, on Thursday, June 13, 2019, at 10:00 a.m. (Pacific Daylight Time).

Proposals to be considered at the Annual Meeting:

- (1) to elect Michael Hsing and Herbert Chang to serve on the Board until the 2022 annual meeting of stockholders of the Company;
- (2) to ratify the appointment of Ernst & Young LLP as the Company's independent registered public accounting firm for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2019; and
- (3) to approve, on an advisory basis, the executive compensation.
